Learn to draw the human form and still-life with this program led by a Battery Park City Parks artist and educator. The class will alternate each week: for five sessions, a live model performs several poses as you practice your skills with the materials provided, including soft pastels, water colors, charcoal and colored pencils. The other sessions will feature still-life arrangements composed by the instructor, who will guide students' creative process recreating what they see.

Instructor **Marla Lipkin** attended The Cooper Union School of Art, Architecture and Engineering, where she studied painting with Paul Resika, Leland Bell and Marcia Marcus. She also has a Masters from Hunter College. **Marla Lipkin's** work draws inspiration from bodies of water and nature. She is currently working on a series of Island at Sea paintings which capture deep turquoise waters and fantastic late day light.
